

Fire Safety Awareness Competition

2009 Rules for Entering

This year's contest is open to all students in Grades K-8.

All entries must be student written and produced in their entirety, with the signed approval of a sponsor and/or teacher.

All entries must be on DVD-R or miniDV tape.

All non-student written and produced materials must include a signed release specifying permission for use from the owner of that material. Name, address, and phone number must be included with the release. This includes all copyrighted and non-copyrighted materials.

Copyright permission must be credited in writing. Entries with copyright violations will be disqualified.

A completed entry form must accompany each student production. Entry forms must be filled in electronically, printed, then signed.

Only material produced during the current school year may be submitted. A presentation completed after a district competition can be entered in the next year's competition at the grade level at which the presentation was completed.

Entries may be produced by an individual, group, class, or club.

All students involved in winning productions will receive awards. The criteria for judging is based on content and technical quality. Judging sheets will be returned to students at all levels of competition.

Only three entries per school.

Each PSA must be EXACTLY 30 seconds or EXACTLY 60 seconds in length.

These same entries may be used for the Jim Harbin Student Media Festival.

All completed productions and entry forms must be in the possession of ITV by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 2009.
